Notes and Maintenance

Proper tools will improve the quality of installation and reduce the time required.

To protect the product, wax after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Refer to the table to the left when securing hardware during the installation process to help prevent damage to the product or vehicle.

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

Step 1

If installed, remove the bumper guard from the truck.

Step 2

Slide the light cage into place from the back side of the bumper guard with the light mounting bar on the bottom.

Align the holes in the bumper guard uprights. Secure with M8 bolts, flat washers and nylock nuts.

Note: Some bumper guards may have two sets of holes for middle and lower mounting locations.

Step 3

Reinstall the bumper guard.
