

## **INSTALLATION STEPS**

- 1. Remove the car's rear bumper by removing three bolts from each flange where the bumper brackets (energy absorbers) attach to chassis. Pull bumper straight back and off of the car. You now have access to the inside of the car's left and right frame rails.
- 2. Temporarily mount the hitch using existing holes at rear of frame rails. The hitch will fit to the bottom surface of the frame rails. Do not use backing plates at this time.
- 3. Using the hitch as a template, drill the bottom surface of the car's frame rails with a 7/16" bit. Remove the hitch from the car.
- 4. place three carriage bolts in the holes in each backing plate. Place one backing plate with bolts inside each frame rail so carriage bolts drop through the holes in the frame rail bottom surface.
- 5. Reposition hitch on car being careful not to push carriage bolts out of place. Install nuts and lock washers onto bolts.
- 6. Torque all hardware to 70 lb-ft.
- 7. Reinstall bumper.
