

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) Lower vehicle exhaust by removing rubber isolator from muffler.
- 2) Enlarge existing hole under frame rail to 1" as shown above.
- 3) Fishwire 1 3/4" carriage bolts with CM-SP6 spacers through access hole and out mounting holes and install 1/2" washers. Raise hitch into position with U-shaped bar above tailpipe, remove fishwires, and secure hitch with 1/2" flange nuts.
- 4) Place remaining 2" carriage bolt through hitch onto tow loop and place small CM-SP12 spacer on bottom of tow loop. Raise passenger side and secure with flange nut.
 - Note: If exhaust hanger rod interferes with side bracket, it may be necessary to bend hanger rod slightly inboard. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 110 ft.-lbs.
- 5) Raise exhaust back into position.






1. Lower vehicle exhaust by removing rubber isolator from muffler.

INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

3. Fishwire 1 3/4" carriage bolts with CM-SP6 spacers through access hole and out mounting holes and install 1/2" washers. Raise hitch into position with U-shaped bar above tailpipe. Remove fishwires and secure hitch with 1/2" flange nuts.



4. Place remaining 2" carriage bolt through hitch onto tow loop and place small CM-SP12 spacer on bottom of tow loop. Raise passenger side and secure with flange nut.

Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 110 ft.-lbs.



5. Raise exhaust back into position if removed prior to installation.

Note: If exhaust hanger rod interferes with side bracket, it may be necessary to bend hanger rod slightly inboard.
