INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:



 Begin bumper cover removal process by removing (1) screw, (1) push fastener from behind rear tire, and (1) push fastener from the wheel well.



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2. Remove (1) screw hidden behind the wheel well at the top of the facia. Remove the plastic clip by prying it out with a flat head screw driver.






3. Remove small plastic panel between tail light and trunk opening. Remove exposed screw.

Repeat STEPS 1-3 on the other side of the vehicle.





INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

4. Remove (8) push fasteners from around the rear of the fascia, with a flat head screw driver.





5. Carefully remove bumper cover. Pop sides off first and then pull straight back.

NOTE: Disconnect electrical connector under driver side tail light.



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6. Remove foam and set aside for reinstall later.






7. Remove bumper beam by removing (8) M8 bolts.





INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

8. With a rotary tool remove alignment stud (each side as shown) and trim the center of the underbody panel (as shown).



9. Raise hitch and bumper beam into position and secure to the vehicle with the M8 bolts removed in STEP 7. Torque all M8 hardware to 23 ft-lbs.



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10. Reinstall bumper cover by reassembling components removed in STEPS 1-6 in reverse order.



11. Install is now complete.







- 4. Remove (8) push fasteners from the rear of the fascia, with a flat head screw driver.
- 5. Carefully remove bumper cover. Pop sides off first and then pull straight back. **Note:** Disconnect electrical connector under driver side tail light.
- 6. Remove foam and set aside for reinstall later.
- 7. Remove bumper beam by removing (8) M8 bolts.
- 8. With a rotary tool remove the lower alignment stud from bumper beam location.
- 9. Trim underbody panel and reinstall. See TRIM DIAGRAM.
- 10. Raise hitch and bumper beam into position and secure to the vehicle with the M8 bolts removed in STEP 7. Torque all M8 hardware to 23 ft-lbs.
- 11. Reinstall bumper cover by reassembling components removed in STEPS 1-6 in reverse order.
