




1. Lower the exhaust by removing (2) rubber isolators. Use a 1/2" socket to remove the bolt that secures the rearmost isolator to the vehicle frame.





2. If a heat shield is present, you need to trim it to access the access hole in the frame.

**Note:** Dimensions are approximate, confirm prior to trimming.



#### **INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:**

3. Fishwire SP2 spacers and 7/16" carriage bolts through access holes and out mounting holes. Raise hitch into position and secure with 7/16" flange nuts.






4. Torque 7/16" hardware to 70-ft lbs. Raise exhaust back into position



#### **INSTALLATION STEPS**

- 1. Lower exhaust by removing (2) rubber isolators from the muffler towards the center of the vehicle and by removing the bolt securing the rearmost hanger to the frame. (See Rubber Isolator Removal Diagram)
- If a heat shield is present you will need to trim it to access the access hole in the frame.See heat shield trim diagram. Note: Dimensions are approximate, confirm prior to trimming.
- 3. Fishwire SP2 spacers and 7/16" carriage bolts through access holes and out mounting holes. (See Fishwire Technique Diagram)
- 4. Raise hitch into position and secure with 7/16" flange nuts.
- 5. Torque 7/16" hardware to 70 ft-lbs.
- 6. Raise exhaust back into position.
