

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) The following fascia fasteners must be removed for hitch installation.
 - * 5 fascia bolts
 - * 8 hex bolts
 - * both rear bumper panels on frame ends

Must remove bumper fascia from clips holding to vehicle.

- 2) Remove or trim bumper pad for hitch clearance.
- 3) Insert hitch into ends of frame rails as shown, and align hitch weldnuts with existing holes in vehicle frame rail.
- 4) Loosely install fasteners into hitch through existing frame holes as shown.
- 5) Using supplied template, align template with bumper fascia, mark and trim for hitch installation.
- 6) Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 37 ft-lbs.
- 7) Re-install bumper fascia and underbody fascia.
