- 2. Remove any plastic/rubber covering at the bottom of the rear bumper where the hitch bracket makes contact. The hitch must seat directly against the metal bumper.
- 3. Using the hitch as a template to mark and drill (4) places in trunk floor, and (2) places in the bottom of the bumper beam. All holes are for 3/8" diameter bolts.
- 4. Bolt the hitch to the floor panel and bumper beam using fasteners as shown. Make sure to install fender washers opposite the hitch inside the trunk.
- 5. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 45 lb-ft.
- 6. Use silicone caulk to seal around fasteners in trunk pan to seal out water and exhaust vapors.
