

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Removing the spare tire may be necessary on some models. When done installing remember to reinstall spare tire.
- 2. Remove two bumper bracket bolts that hold bracket to vehicle frame, repeat on other side. Note: Bumper brackets remain in place.
- 3. Install hitch to vehicle by inserting two M10 bolts with 3/8" conical washers through the two forward holes on arm flange fasten to existing weld nuts hand tight. Note: hitch must be lifted into position at an angle so that flanges of the hitch will clear flanges on bumper bracket.
- 4. Using hitch as a template, drill 3/8" dia. hole in bumper, fasten with 3/8-16 hex bolt and 3/8-16 hex flange nut.
- 5. Torque all 3/8 fasteners to 45 lb.-ft. Torque all M10 fasteners to 47 lb.ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
