

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) Lower exhaust by removing (4) rubber isolators. (See Rubber Isolator Removal Diagram.)
- 2) Enlarge center holes to allow spacer and carriage bolts to pass through. (See Hole Enlargement Diagram.)
- 3) Fishwire 1st and 2nd carriage bolts and spacers into position as shown. (Both sides; See Fishwire Technique.)
- 4) Reverse fishwire 3rd carriage bolt and spacer into center hole. (Both sides; See Reverse Pull Fishwire Technique.)
- 5) Raise hitch into position and attach using the hex flange nuts.
- 6) Torque all 1/2" hardware to 110 lb-ft.
- 7) Install rubber exhaust isolators removed in Step 1.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
