

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. If there is a trim shield attached to the lower edge of vehicle rear bumper, it must be removed before hitch can be installed. After removing the trim shield, be sure to reinstall all fasteners taken from bumper.
- 2. Remove the spare tire from its under vehicle storage location. It will be reinstalled after the hitch is in place.
- 3. Position the hitch up under vehicle so that it will align with the two weldnuts in each end of the vehicle cross member and one weldnut in the inner side of each frame.
- 4. Bolt the hitch in place using 12mm hex bolts and conical washers at locations shown.
- 5. Torque all the 12mm bolts to 86 lb.-ft. Failure to tighten bolts as described may result in fastener loss or failure.
- 6. Reposition the spare tire back into its storage location.
