





## **ASSEMBLY**









#### Step 1

Remove any stickers covering the holes on the outside of the frame rails.

If equipped, remove the tie down bracket from the bottom of the passenger-side frame rail and return it to the vehicle owner.






#### Step 2

Raise the trailer hitch into position and loosely secure with the provided hardware (#1, #2).

Torque all M12 hardware to 86 ft-lbs.
