

- 2) Drill an 1-1/4" access hole in frame approximately half way between the M12 weldnut and the existing hole.
- 3) Fishwire the 1/2" carriage bolts and spacers through the access holes and out the existing holes as shown. Leave fishwires attached to bolts.
- 4) Raise the hitch into position against the bottom of vehicle frame and thread the fishwires through the hitch.

Note: Muffler brackets will be located between the frame and hitch bracket.

- 5) Install supplied 1/2" flange nuts and re-install M12 bolts from step 1. If single exhaust, on the passenger side use items 5, 6, and 7 in place of bracket. Hand tighten all fasteners.
- 6) Torque all 1/2" bolts to 110 lb-ft and all M12 fasteners to 79 lb-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
