
Periodic inspection of the trailer hitch should be performed to ensure all mounting hardware remains tight and structural components are secure.


To help prevent damage to the product or vehicle, refer to the specified torque specifications when securing hardware during the installation process.

# **ASSEMBLY**





### Step 1

Remove the seven (7) fasteners from the bottom of the center insert on the rear bumper.





### Step 2

Remove the electrical retention clip from the bumper cover insert at each end of the panel.





### Step 3

Remove the lower center panel from the bumper cover by carefully pushing in the tabs from the back of the panel while pushing the panel away from the vehicle.



### Step 4

Using a 13mm socket, remove the bottom bolt and middle bolt located towards the center of each bumper beam support. Remove the top bolt toward the center of the vehicle on the passenger side only.





# Step 5

Raise the hitch (#1) into position and loosely secure it with M8 bolts (#2) and conicaltoothed washers (#3)





# Step 6

Torque M8 hardware to 23 ft-lbs.

Reinstall the bottom panel following steps 1-3 in reverse order.
