## Level of Difficulty

Ratchet	Socket extension, 8"
Socket, 12mm	Socket, 19mm
Torque wrench	Torque adapter, 19mm

Safety glasses should be worn at all times while installing this product.

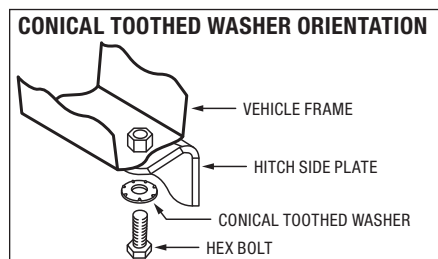
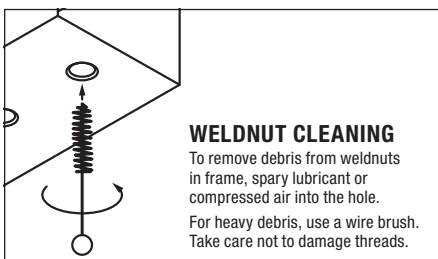
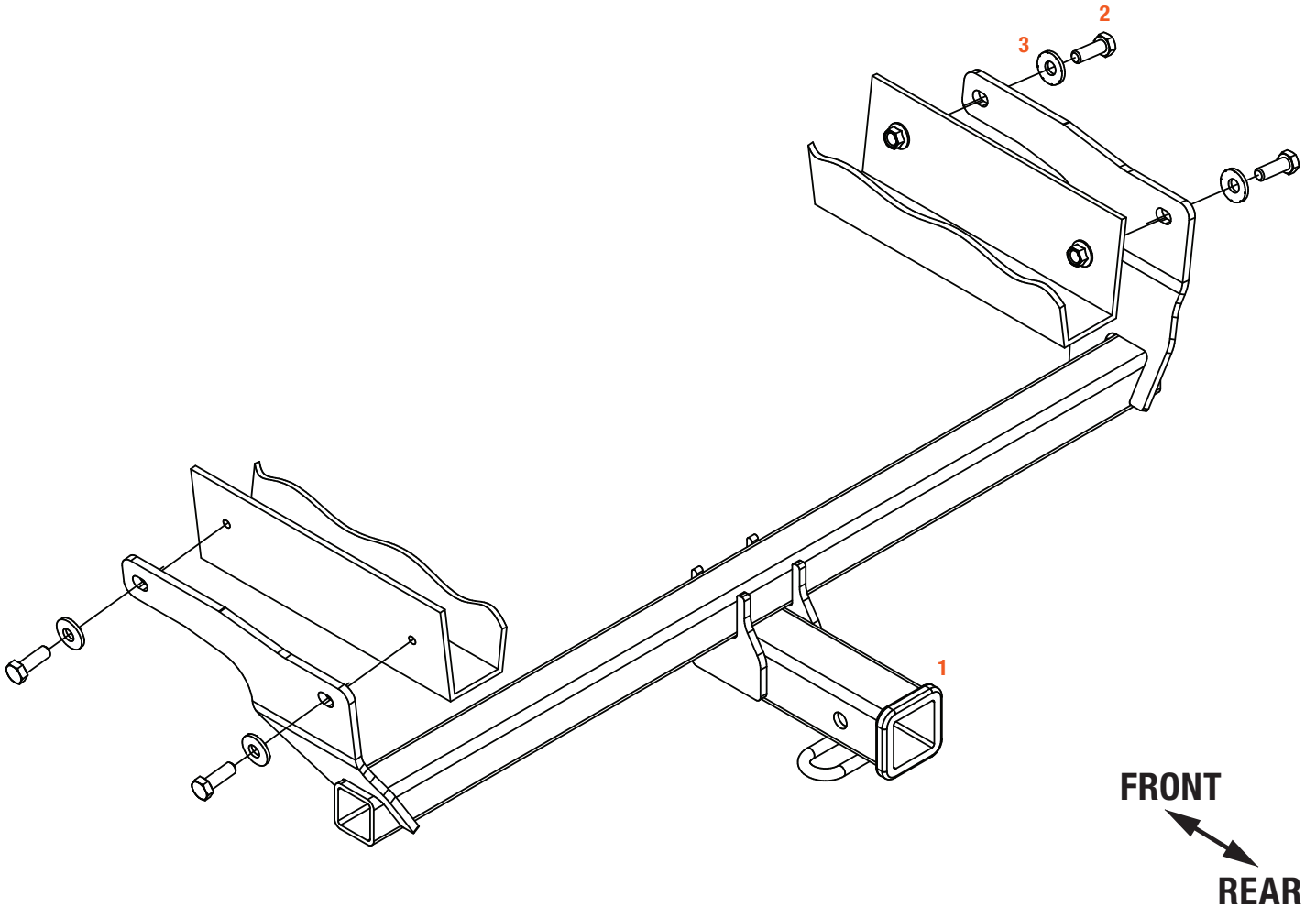

# ASSEMBLY

## Parts List

Item	Qty	Description
1	1	Trailer hitch
2	4	Hex bolt, M12 – 1.25 x 35mm, CL 10.9
3	4	Conical-toothed washer, 1/2"



### Step 1

Remove stickers covering holes on outside of frame rails.



### Step 2

Raise hitch into position and loosely secure with supplied hardware.

**Note:** Lowering the exhaust using 12mm socket may ease installation on some models, be sure to support exhaust if lowering.



### Step 3

Torque M12 hardware to 86 ft-lbs.

**Note:** If heat shield is contacting hitch, bend the heat shield up to prevent rattling.
