

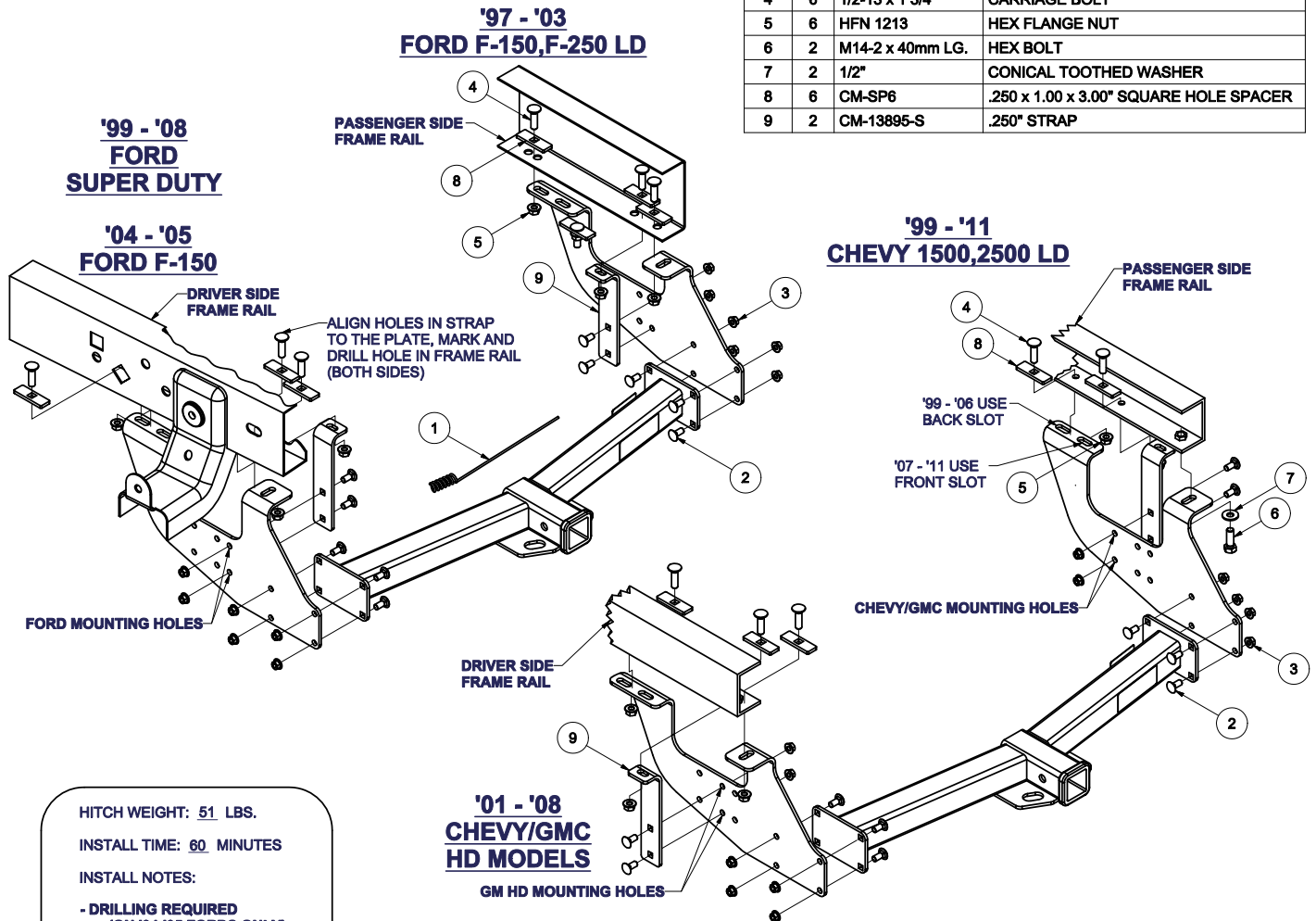

INSTALL NOTES:

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) Place supplied fasteners into position on vehicle where possible without drilling, per application.
- 2) Mount side plates to frame rails as shown above (Ford in, Chevy/GMC out). Raise center section into position and loosely secure to side plates.
- 3) Drill remaining holes if necessary. ('03-'04 Ford trucks)
- 4) Install remaining fasteners.
- 5) Torque all 7/16" fasteners to 70 lb-ft, all 1/2" fasteners to 110 lb-ft, and all 14mm fasteners to 126 lb-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
